Camp Options:

Staying with the team: When your child travels with the team, SSRA coaches provide chaperoning. Camp costs include all lift tickets, lodging, team van, coach costs, and all meals. Cost: \$625

Staying with your family: Camp costs include all lift tickets, team van, coach costs, and meal plan. Cost \$500

Cost Details: SSRA runs these camps to break even on costs. In the event that money is saved, you will receive a refund. In the unlikely event that the cost of the camp exceeds estimates, participants will be billed.

Lodging: Upper Village condos. Lodging is reserved by SSRA coaches, unless you are travelling with family. If you need to book a unit, contact Amy Green at 250.341.3031.

Travel Documentation: Make sure to get appropriate border crossing documents in order. It is advisable to have a passport. However, minors may be allowed to cross with a birth certificate and/or photo ID. Minors travelling across the border with the team must bring a Border Crossing Authorization Letter. *This must be signed by both parents/guardians and notarized.* Those travelling with one parent or another family will also need these letters; signed and notarized.
